Consultation objectives:

As a result of participating in the group consultation, participants will:

- Increase clinical skills
- Experience an increase in clinical confidence
- Explore and apply options for clinical interventions
- Identify methods to address issues of impasse(s) or resistance in the clinical process
- Discuss the use of various modalities, e.g. art therapy, gestalt, CBT, and psychodynamic as ways to address clinical needs
- Receive feedback about clinical cases
- Learn ways to integrate new techniques into clinical practice
- Gain insight, knowledge and skills through the experiential process
